Leading The Way

Tom McEwen and Toledo De Kerser, members of Britain's gold medal-winning team at the 2018 World Equestrian Games, are in the lead after the second day of dressage at the French CCI5 at Pau. They scored 25, which gives them an advantage of just 0.6 of a penalty over Tim Price and Wesko.*

It is the first time Tom led the dressage at CCI5 level. He and 12-year-old Toledo De Kerser, owned by Fred and Penny Barker, Jane Inns and Tom's mother Ali, scored marginally better at Badminton this spring — 24.7, which left them fourth after the first phase.*



Victory For Italians

Italian equestrians won the first and second place and a Swiss national took the third in the final stage of the Morocco Royal Tour for show-jumping.

The third stage of the Morocco Royal Tour for show-jumping ended with two Italians claiming top prizes. Roberto Torchito took home the King Mohammed VI Grand Prix and Natale Chiaudani came second. With 36.98 seconds, Torchito sealed the win in the Morocco Royal Tour's final stage on the horse "Baron." Chiaudani came second on "Chopard" with 37.30 seconds. In the third place was Elian Baumann of Switzerland on "Campari Z" with a time of 40.21.

Win For Pranay Khare

Pranay Khare of URB club won the highest category 130 cm of show jumping in October, Equestrian Premier League 2019 held at Embassy International Riding School

The EPL tournament has 3 categories -

Children's Category (80 cm Show Jumping and Pre-Novice Children Dressage), Junior Category (100 cm show Jumping and Pre-Novice Junior Dressage), Open category (130 cm show Jumping and Novice Dressage)

EIRS and EPL have produced several star performers, one of them being Fouaad Mirza, the 27-year-old who was the Indian rider to win the silver medal in the Asian Games 2018 held in Jakarta, after 36 years. Team India sponsored by Embassy won a silver in Eventing, and included Fouaad Mirza, Jitender Singh, Ashish Malik and Rakesh Kumar.



Host To An Equestrian Event

For the first time, Oman will host the 2 showjumping world-cup qualifiers at Al-Rahba grounds, Barka in cooperation with the Oman Equestrian Federation, Ministry of Sports Affairs and Oman Olympic Committee. Founded in 2017, by the Olympic Equestrian Federation training centre and with the provision of Tanfeedh (National Programme for Enhancing Economic Diversification), Muscat Showjumping Series is part of a long-standing tradition revered by equine fans.*

The event will bring together a host of global and regional equestrian talent — providing the Middle East with a platform to be globally recognised as an equestrian hub with its rapid elevation in status. Participating riders represent countries, such as Oman, UAE, UK, Jordan, Egypt, Ireland, the USA, Poland, Holland, KSA, Qatar and Kuwait.

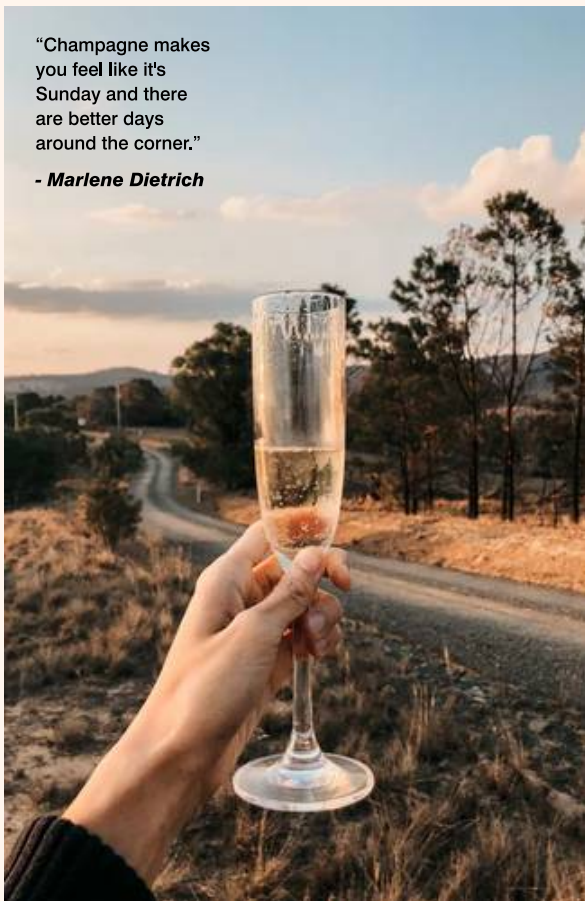

Are Wine and Champagne Same?

Wine and Champagne start out exactly the same. Champagne is wine that has just been processed differently to get the bubbles. Grape varietals such as Chardonnay and Pinot Noir are grown in vineyards all over the world. The grapes are allowed to ripen on the vine until the brix level is within the range that the winemaker is looking for. Brix is a measurement of sugar. Brix levels can range from 19.5 to 26! The higher the Brix, higher the sugar and higher the sugar, higher the alcohol by volume (ABV). Grapes used for Champagne are usually between 18-21 brix and end up with an ABV of 11%.

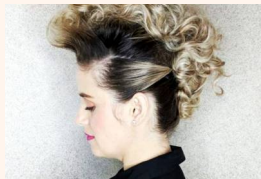


