Horse Whispering- Is It Even Real?

Horse whispering has been questioned for quite some time now, and so LA POLO talks to the expert himself.

The technique of horse whispering has been critically questioned and doubted. They have been claimed as being just a fancy name and as nothing as a magic or power that people otherwise believe it to be. People have also questioned it for being real. And so, LA POLO got in a conversation with one of the experts himself. We bring to you one of the famous horse whisperers- Andrew Froggatt. Let's read along and find out.

LA POLO: "If Andrew can't fix it, nobody can." This statement is an accomplishment in itself, and it does not come only out of work; it requires an equal amount of passion and determination. How did it all happen to you?

ANDREW FROGGATT: *Re-the quote, "if Andrew cannot fix it nobody can". This came about as when I started out, I became a last resort for people if nothing else worked with their horses. People usually try and do as much as they can themselves, before they look to spend money but often in doing that the problem just gets worse. Then they try people, who still cannot get the horse right and eventually they would come to me. Horses that were totally written off as nutcases or mad by other trainers, I would turn them around and send them out again as winners. Often by the time I got the horses there had been three to four people who had all had a go at fixing them, and had used...*

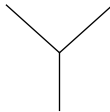

Catastrophic Injuries

A 3-year-old colt sustained a catastrophic injury in the eighth race at Santa Anita and was euthanized Saturday, the 32nd horse to die at the track since December. Two-time Kentucky Derby-winning jockey Mario Gutierrez was tossed off in the incident on the second day of the fall meet at Santa Anita, where the Breeders' Cup World Championships are to be run in November. Track officials said Gutierrez wasn't injured after landing near the inner rail. He was taken away by ambulance. Track veterinarian Dr. Dana Stead said in a statement that Emtech had two broken front legs and she made the decision to euthanize the colt on the track. Workers hurried to put up a green screen to shield the foundering colt from the crowd, its front legs unable to withstand the animal's weight.

Dr. Dionne Benson, chief vet for The Stronach Group, which owns Santa Anita, said a review would be opened to consider the factors that contributed to Emtech's injury. She said the colt would have a necropsy at the UC Davis School of Veterinary Medicine, which is mandatory for all on-track accidents.

Horse race in Saudi Arabia

Two more races have been added to the undercard of the world's richest horse race, the Saudi Cup, to take place in the Kingdom next year, organisers have announced. The inaugural meeting of the \$20 million (Dh73.4m) Saudi Cup takes place on February 29 at the King Abdulaziz Racetrack in Riyadh with a race for Purebred Arabians and a handicap for thoroughbreds trained in Saudi now added to race day. The meeting consists of eight races with total prize money increased to \$29.2m.

“Our Saudi Cup day is providing all of us here in the racing community of Saudi Arabia with wonderful new opportunities,” said Prince Bandar bin Khalid Al Faisal, chairman of the Jockey Club of Saudi Arabia. He added, “For the first time, Saudi jockeys, trainers and owners will be able to pit their talents and their horses against some of the best in the sport. The chance to compete against the world's finest is the chance to learn from the best.”


